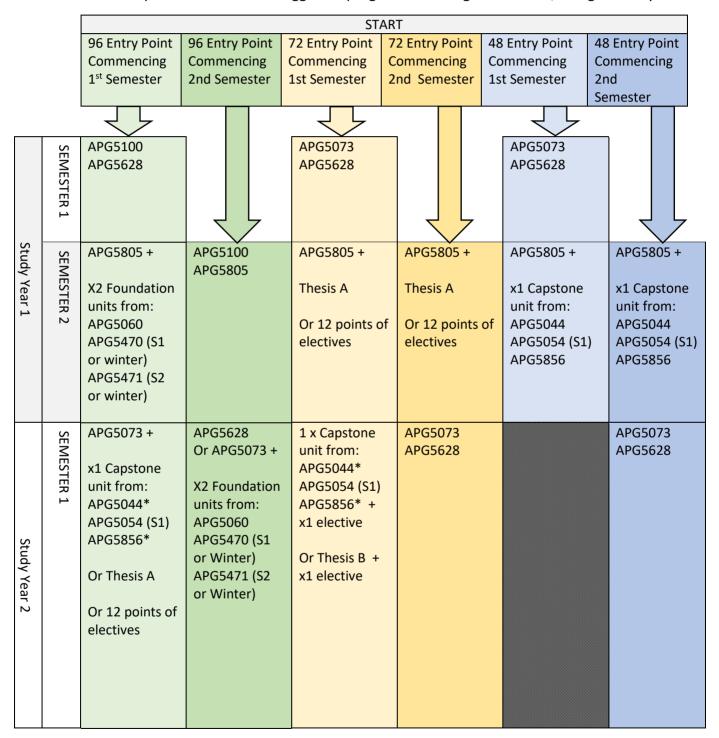


## Course progression map for 2019 commencing students
