Students are advised to:

- Complete four Research Project units (PSY4401, PSY4402, PSY4403, PSY4404), three Core units (PSY4405, PSY4406, PSY4407) and your choice of one Elective unit (PSY4408 or PSY4409)
- Take the Research Project units in consecutive order, i.e. PSY4401 then PSY4402 then PSY4403 then PSY4404 & PSY4400.
- The elective units, PSY4408 and PSY4409, are offered once or twice per year in alternating years.
- Only enrol in one unit per Teaching Period.
